- Pre-evangelism
- Making the transition from general talk to spiritual talk

Session 5 *What if they object to the message? (October 10)*

- Why do people object?
- What is apologetics/what is it not?
- How do I respond to objections?

Session 6 *So, what now? (November 7)*

- Review some opportunities you've had to talk faith and the blessings that come from evangelism
- Take an opportunity to discuss what we as a church/individuals can do next

Goals of Evangelism University

2. To strengthen the faith of the participants by encouraging personal Bible study outside of class
3. To build the confidence of God's people to verbalize their faith
4. To identify ways we can better evangelize as individuals and as a congregation
